Music Supervisor, Laura Webb, has over twenty years' experience in music and entertainment. Her work has garnered two wins for Best Music Supervision for Television Limited Series or Movie for her work on ***TO ALL THE BOYS I'VE LOVED BEFORE & TO ALL THE BOYS: PS I STILL LOVE YOU*** -as well as five other nominations from the Guild of Music Supervisors for Best Music Supervision in a Drama, Best Music Supervision in Reality Television.

She was named one Ten Top Music Supervisors to Watch in Variety in 2021. Laura grew up in Atlanta, GA. and went to high school in Munich, Germany. She moved to Los Angeles, where she graduated from University of Southern of California. Webb started her career working with famed music supervisors Laura Wasserman & Darren Higman at WH/ Avenger Entertainment. While there, she served as Music Coordinator on films such as ***SHARK TALE, A LOT LIKE LOVE, XXX2: STATE OF THE UNION***. Other music coordinator credits include ***500 DAYS OF SUMMER***, and ***THE HILLS*** on MTV. In 2009, Laura created her own company, Webb Worldwide Music. Under her own banner, Laura's credits include: all three of the Netflix massive hit films in the ***TO ALL THE BOYS I'VE LOVED BEFORE*** franchise. MTV's social media giant, Saturn Award-winning show, ***TEEN WOLF*** (all six seasons) & the recently released ***TEEN WOLF: THE MOVIE***; Nickelodeon and Paramount+'s musical ***MONSTER HIGH***, based on the Mattel franchise. Netflix & ACE Films ***HELLO, GOODBYE, AND EVERYTHING IN BETWEEN***, starring Jordan Fisher, ACE Films' ***LOVE AT FIRST SIGHT*** set in London, SYFY & Amblin produced show ***RESIDENT ALIEN***, the final season of Netflix's ***ATYPICAL, SIREN***, a breakout series on Freeform, ***SACRED LIES*** a scripted series for Facebook Watch. Working on the reality side, Laura supervised, Amazon's ***FOREVER SUMMER: HAMPTONS***, Netflix's ***DOWN TO EARTH WITH ZAC EFRON: DOWN UNDER, WORLD OF JENKS, THE CITY, HOW'S YOUR NEWS, 2012 MTV MOVIE AWARDS***.
